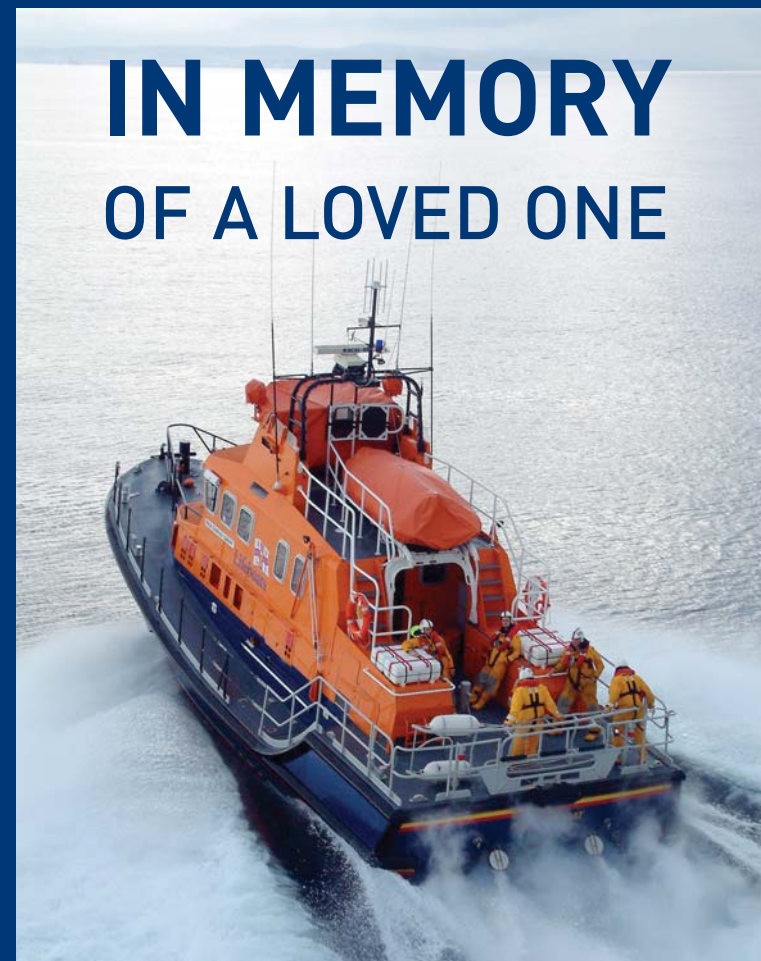

Since the RNLI was founded in 1824,  
its lifeboats have saved more than 136,000 lives.

In 2003, our volunteer crews rescued over 7,900 people around the UK and Republic of Ireland.

The lifeboat service costs over £110M or €165M a year to run and is supported by voluntary contributions. A donation of £40
